## Densah<sup>®</sup> Burs Maintenance & Replacement

## Surgical drills and burs should be replaced after 12-20 osteotomies\* or sooner when they are dulled or worn.

Cutting and Densifying must be done under constant water irrigation. A pumping motion is required to prevent overheating. It is recommended to keep a spare set of Densah® Burs on hand in the event replacement is needed during a surgery.
